



The Regional Cancer Center's Mobile Mammography Facts

- ✧ Early detection of breast cancer is the key to successfully treating it.
- ✧ Women age 40 and over should have a mammogram (breast cancer screening) once a year.
- ✧ The Regional Cancer Center provides breast cancer screenings to women nearby their home, workplace or church on the Mobile Mammography Vehicle.

Mobile Program Info

- ✧ The Mobile Mammography Program started in 2000.
- ✧ The Mobile Season runs from March ~ November traveling a 50 mile radius of The Regional Cancer Center within Erie & Crawford County.
- ✧ We visit nearly 50 different sites each year, averaging about 850 breast screenings per year.
- ✧ Funding may be available from the mammogram voucher programs by grants from the Susan G. Komen for the Cure Foundation, disbursed by the PA Healthy Woman Program, administered by Adagio Health and funded by the PA Dept. of Health.
- ✧ Appointments are required for mammograms at each of the host sites. Women must call The Regional Cancer Center at 838-9000 or 1-800-477-6647 to schedule.
