



Here is Some Helpful Information about Mobile Mammography That Might Help You as a Site Coordinator

1. Fees and Insurance

- Screenings provided to insured patients will be billed to the individual's insurance company
- Uninsured patients will need to call the Mammogram Voucher Program at 1-888-687-0505 to obtain a voucher for a no cost mammogram

2. Protocol for Scheduling

- **Women must call The Regional Cancer Center in advance to provide information and have their appointment scheduled. Call 838-9000 or 1-800-447-6647 at least a week in advance.**
- The Regional Cancer Center provides confidential results by mail to all patient, and will contact referring physician with abnormal results by phone
- The Regional Cancer Center will fax results to the patient's physician



3. Scheduled Screening Date and Time

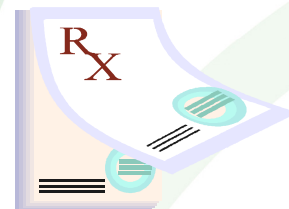
- The mobile unit will begin checking-in patients for their screenings no earlier than 8:45 a.m.
- These times are subject to change depending on site location

4. Site Requirements

- Each site location will provide one designated contact to assist The Regional Cancer Center team with screening logistics.
- There must be a level paved area for parking with a 34 foot length accommodation
- Each site location will provide a fax machine and restroom to be used by our employees

5. Patient Eligibility

- Women 40 years of age and older
- **Have a referring physician willing to accept screening results and provide the patient with a prescription for the mammogram**
- Have not had a mammogram in the last year
- Are not pregnant or breast-feeding and do not have breast implants
- Are ambulatory and able to maneuver the unit stairs
